3月12日の水素爆発前に大熊町から避難。
母と長女とともに岡山へ避難（原発から約
1000km）。定期的に福島に通い、津波で犠牲と
なった父、妻、次女の捜索を継続。

I evacuated from Okuma Town before the
hydrogen explosion on March 12.
I took refuge in Okayama, about 1,000
kilometers from the nuclear power plant, with
my mother and eldest daughter.
I regularly returned to Fukushima to search
for my father, wife, and younger daughter
who were lost in the tsunami.
