

Thierry Schneider is the Director of Nuclear Protection Evaluation Centre (CEPN) in France, a research organisation dedicated to assessment and management of radiological risk. In addition, since 2025, he is professor of radiological protection and risk communication at the Atomic Bomb Disease Institute at Nagasaki University.

He has a PhD in economics from University Paris-Dauphine in the field of health and insurance, focussing on the management of occupational diseases and injuries.

He is currently Member of Main Commission of the International Commission on Radiological Protection (ICRP) and the Chair of Committee 4 on the application of the system of radiological protection.

Up to April 2026, Thierry Schneider is Chairing the NEA Committee on Radiological Protection and Public Health (CRPPH), with significant implications on stakeholder involvement and recovery preparedness for nuclear accident. Up to 2021, he was also the chair the European research NERIS Platform on preparedness for nuclear emergency response and recovery.

He has been involved in research projects related to the assessment and management of radiological risk, including social and ethical issues. He has been involved in post-accident management projects since 1990 at the national, European and international levels.
