

ICRP Seeks Cost Free Staff Loan

As part of an effort to modernize and strengthen our operations, the International Commission on Radiological Protection (ICRP) is seeking expressions of interest from organizations that may wish to provide a cost-free staff loan to the ICRP Scientific Secretariat.


Under direct supervision of the Scientific Secretary, and based in the ICRP Secretariat offices in Ottawa, Canada, the incumbent would be responsible for specific duties initially including tasks such as:

- updating information on the ICRP web site and assisting with preparation of other communications materials;
- assisting with administrative aspects of publishing the Annals of the ICRP;
- making or assisting with arrangements ahead of and during some ICRP meetings (in particular meetings of the Main Commission);
- organizing the historical archives of ICRP; and,
- assisting with general administration of the Scientific Secretariat.

It is anticipated that the incumbent would gain an insight into the workings of ICRP as well as benefit from interactions with ICRP members and other experts in radiological protection worldwide.

Specific terms will be negotiated, but ICRP envisages a one-year term with a possibility of renewal, with the loaning organization covering salary, benefit, and relocation costs.
